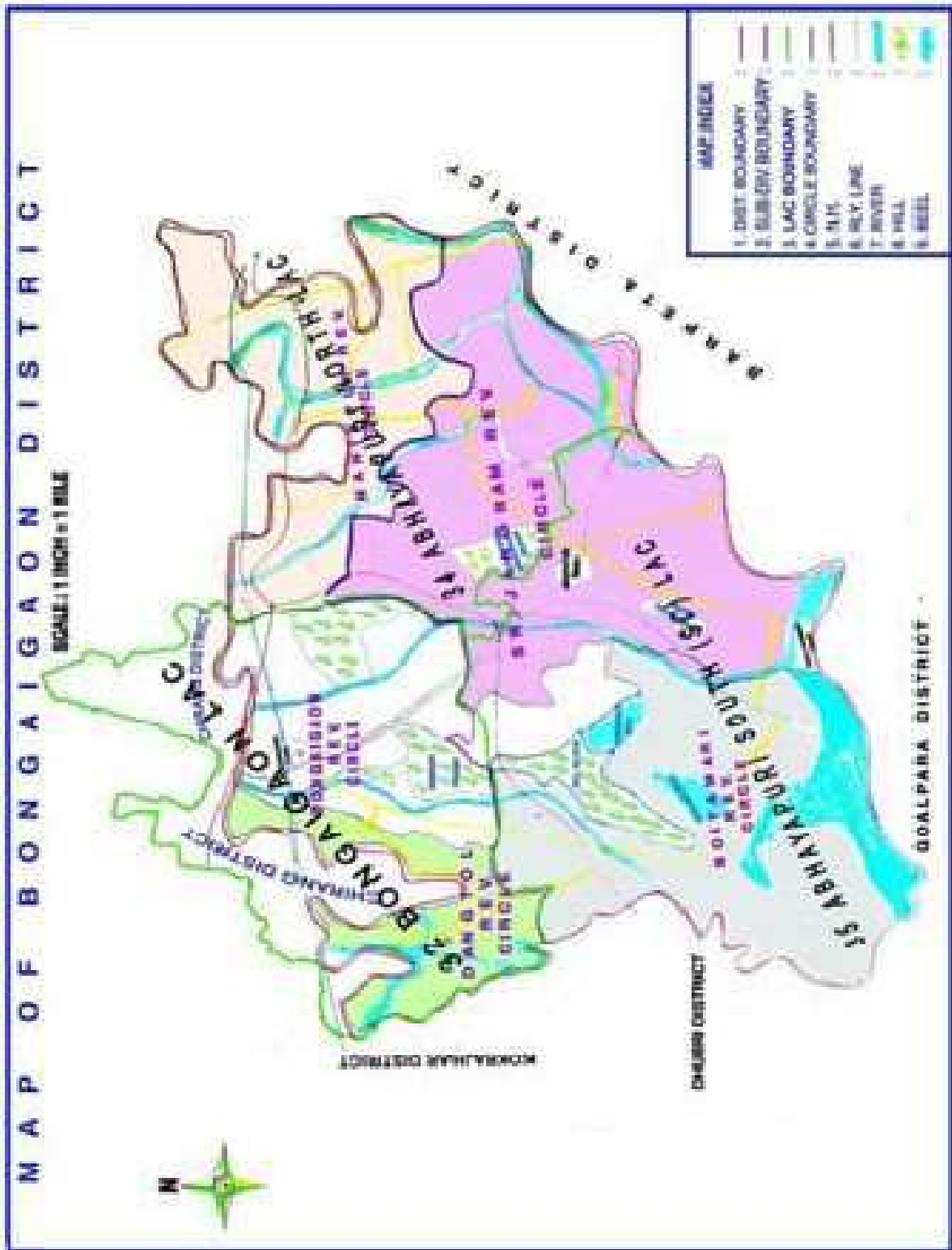

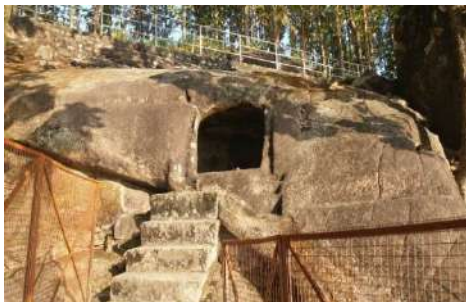

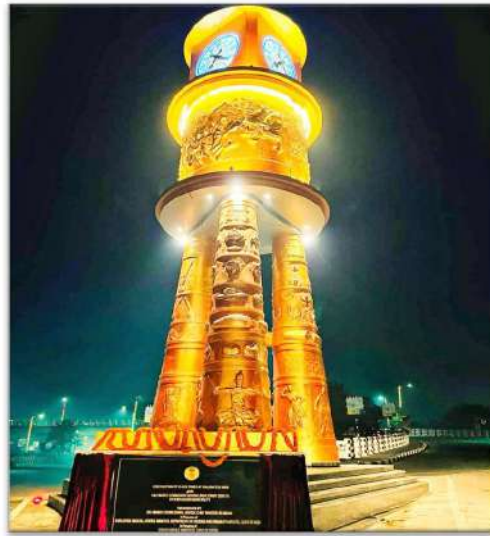

## **Bongaigaon at a glance**

### **BONGAIGAON DISTRICT & ITS CREATION:**

Bongaigaon is an old name but a new district. It was declared a district on 29th September 1989 and carved out from erstwhile Goalpara and Kokrajhar District. The Bongaigaon District is situated in the western part of the State of Assam and bounded by the districts Kokrajhar, Goalpara, Barpeta, Chirang, Dhubri

### **ORIGIN & HISTORY:**

There is a lot of controversy surrounding its original name. According to local inhabitants, the name of present Bongaigaon town was Birjhora-dhigi while the Bongaigaon village is about 41km. south of the present township which is now known as 'Purani Bongaigaon'. According to some, the name Bongaigaon has come from the Bodo word 'Bongaigami', meaning 'a group of villagers.'

### **ARCHAEOLOGY:**

The district preserves a host of ancient monuments of different faiths. Ancient architecture in the form of innumerable caves are seen on the hills at Jhogighopa situated at the southern part of the district on the northern banks of the Brahmaputra river. These are said to have been used by Monks in ancient times for meditation. The temple 'Bageshwari' represents the tribal culture and faith of the region.

### **GEOGRAPHY:**

The topography of the district is generally plain. A few small hills here and there cover the district. The mighty Brahmaputra River flows along the southern boundary & its tributary AIE river flows through the district, besides many small rivulets and streams. The district falls within the latitude of 26-degree 28 minutes North to 26-degree 54 minutes North and longitude of 89-degree East to 90-degree 96 minutes East.

### **WEATHER & CLIMATE:**

The climate in the district is moderate in winter. It is hot and humid from May to October varying the temperature from 13 Degree Celsius to 32 Degree Celsius. Monsoon starts in the district from April. The heaviest rainfall occurs during the month of May-June-July and August. The average rainfall is 250 cm to 350 cm.

iii) **By Road:** [National Highway 31](#) connects Bongaigaon with the states of [Bihar](#), [Jharkhand](#) and [West Bengal](#). [National Highway 37](#) via [Naranarayan Setu](#) from [Goalpara](#) in Assam to [Dimapur](#) in [Nagaland](#) traverses the entire length of Assam and connects Bongaigaon with almost all the major cities of Assam, including [Jorhat](#) and [Dibrugarh](#). National Highways 31C and 37 both connect Bongaigaon with Guwahati.

## Health & Family Welfare: Bongaigaon District.

District Health Society, Bongaigaon along with District Administration has made tremendous progress upon different health Indicators, be it reducing MMR, IMR and TFR along with other health parameters is impressive and inspiring towards excellence. It is also worth mentioning that, after tremendous effort. Bongaigaon district is able to reduce MMR and IMR drastically. In the year 2023-24, no maternal death has been reported in compare to 2022-23 where maternal Death



were 6 nos. in the year 2023-24, 54 nos. of Infant death were reported in compare to 106 Nos in the year 2022-23. All these were possible due to optimal input provided by the Health Department and the District Administration.

Since inception, Bongaigaon district has made significant development. In the year 2011 Bongaigaon Civil Hospital was established. The very established of District Hospital has changed the life of many for Bongaigaon district as well as for the neighboring district like Chirang, Goalpara and Dhubri. Since then, the district hospital has given the minimum assured services like general OPD and IPD, Emergency and obstetrics care, Diagnostic and other Para clinical services and also Dialysis unit has been added. It is also worth mentioning that in the year 2021, Sept. 20 bedded ICU was established along with Medical Oxygen Plant. Further, under CSR Fund from IOL, Bongaigaon Construction of Nutritional Rehabilitation center/Mother & Child Ward in the premises at Bongaigaon Civil Hospital amounting Rs. 3,78,84,600/- and Procurement and installation of medical oxygen gas generation plant and booster compressor for cylinder refilling Rs. 2,79,66,000/- were proposed and work has been completed.



Under, AB-PMJAY, out of 5,08,691 NFSA'13 beneficiaries, 412819 nos. beneficiaries had already been completed e-KYC updation and 1,53,638 AB-PMJAY Card has been distributed to the beneficiaries. 6593 patients who are having PMJAY Card got free treatment at Bongaigaon District.

**Janani Suraksha Yojana (JSY):** The JSY is a programme for encouragement of the pregnant women for institutional delivery where incentive Rs. 1400/- (Rural) and 1000/- (Urban) is given to the Pregnant woman for Govt. institutional delivery. After introduction of JSY, Institutional delivery has been increased from 7% in 2005-06 to 99% in the year 2023-24.

1. Under CM Free diagnostic Scheme, in the year 2023-24 (Apr to Sept) 2,56,975 patients got free Laboratory services, 5671 patients got X-Ray and 4642 patients got CT Scan services in Bongaigaon District.
2. Boat Clinic rendering health care services to the people living in the char area at their door step covering riverine areas under Boitamari and Srijangram BPHC since 2010 in the district. In the year 2023-24 (Apr to Sept) boat clinic has conducted 131 camps at char area where 8333 patients got the benefit of health care services. 3271 children got vaccination, 188 Pregnant women got registered and treated, 5002 patients got free laboratory services and also family planning services.

**Nutrition Rehabilitation centre (NRC):** One 10 bedded NRC is set up at Bongaigaon Civil Hospital to provide nutritious food and treatment to SAM (Mal nourished) Children. Total 73 nos. of SAM children received nutritious food and treatment in NRC in the year 2023-24 (Apr – Sept).

3. In Bongaigaon District 548 TB patient have been detected from January to July 2023 and they were provided with free TB treatment. Success Rate of TB treatment of Bongaigaon District is 88.28%. TB patients are also provided with Rs. 500/- per month under NPY (Nikshay Poshan Yojna) direct in to their bank account (through DBT) upto their treatment period for support to their family. Moreover, TB patients were also supported with “Nutritional Support Food Packet” under “Community Support to TB Patients Scheme” (popularly known as Nikshay Mitra Scheme) provided by Nikshay Mitra’s (Community Friends) such BRPL, Spandan Diagnostic Center and others. **In Bongaigaon District TB incidents rate has been reduced up to 40% for which Bongaigaon District got Silver Medal in national level from Central TB Division, Govt. of India.**
4. Unique ID for Persons with Disabilities” project is being implemented with a view of creating a National Database for PwDs, and to issue a Unique Disability Identity Card to each person with disabilities. The project will not only encourage transparency, efficiency and ease of delivering the government benefits to the person with disabilities, but also ensure uniformity. In Bongaigaon District, in the year 2022-23, 1550 Unique ID for Persons with Disabilities were provided and in 2023-24, 144 Person with disabilities got Unique ID.
5. Under National Ambulance services, there are 25 nos of 108 ambulances which are providing Emergency services in Bongaigaon District and 2 nos of Mobile Medical Units are giving services at the most remote and uncovered area population in the district.

## Agriculture

### Different schemes undergoing under Agriculture Department in Bongaigaon District

Different schemes carried out under Agricultural Department in Bongaigaon District for the benefit of the farmers. The Schemes are mentioned in the following.

#### A. Flagship Programs:-

**1. PM-KISAN:-** Under the Scheme, eligible farmers are being provided Rs 6,000/- per year through DBT for catering their farming needs. At present 45,906 nos. of farmers have got benefit and efforts have been taken to cover the remaining farmers.

**2. PMFBY( Prime Minister Fasal Bima Yojana) :** This year under Kharif,2023-24, all together 21,486 nos of farmers have been insured for Sali paddy, and Black gram such that they may get rid of crop loss due to natural calamities.

**3. PMKSY ( Prime Minister Krishi Sinchayee Yojana) :-** Under the Scheme , Sprinkler and Drip irrigation sets are given to farmers at 85% subsidy rate. 104 Sprinkler irrigation Set & 10 nos. of Drip irrigation sets distributed in 2022-23. In 2023-24 till date 11 nos. Drip sets are distributed and another 444 nos of applications have been received under Per Drop More Crop (PDMC).

**4. CMSGUY (Chief Minister Samagra Gramya Unnayan Yojana):** - Under this Scheme 3 nos of Combine harvester (1 No per LAC) is allotted at 90% subsidy to the district. Combine harvesters to 3 FPC's - Barekamara FPC (LAC- Abhayapuri South (SC) Rose Valley FPC (LAC- Abhayapuri North) & Maa Tuniya Jutiya FPC (LAC- 32-Bongaigaon). Till now 2 nos. of Combine harvester has been already distributed to Barekamara FPC& Rose Valley FPC. 3<sup>rd</sup> Combine Harvester will be distributed soon

#### B. Central Schemes: -

**1. RKVY (Rastriya Krishi Vikash Yojana):** - This is a Central Sponsored Scheme. Under the Scheme, Improved varieties of seeds (Paddy, Pulses, Oilseeds, Maize & Vegetables) are distributed among the Farmers. Along with the seeds biological fertilizers and need based pesticides are given to farmers for Scientific Crop production. Seeds of *Sali* Paddy are also given for raising Community *Sali* Paddy seedlings to cater the needs of needy farmers. Farm Machineries like- Power Tiller, Pulveriser & Mini Oil mill is given to farmers for Farm Mechanization

**2. FNS (Food and Nutrition Security):-** FNS which was earlier known as NFSM (National Food Security Mission) is a Central Scheme. Under the Scheme Paddy seeds (HYV, Hybrid & Local) , Pulses Seeds ( Black Gram, Green Gram, Lentil & Pea), Oilseeds ( Mustard & Sesame), Millets ( Foxtail millets & Finger millets) and Maize seeds is given to farmers both for Demonstration and Distribution Programme . Along with the seeds biological fertilizers and need based pesticides are given to farmers for Scientific Crop production. Farm implements like Power Tiller, Rotavator , Sprayer and Pump- sets are given to farmers at subsidized rates. Farmers Training for Scientific training are also imparted to Farmers for Scientific Crop Production.

**3. HMNEH ( Horticulture Mission for North East and Himalayan States) :** Under this scheme different Horticultural crops such as Budded Orange Cuttings, Tissue Culture Banana sucker , High yielding varieties of Fruits and Vegetable Seeds were distributed among the farmers for development of Horticulture sector. Apart from these Agricultural Machineries like Power Tiller, Multipurpose Pulveriser is also

distributed to the registered farmers under Hort.net Portal. 72 nos Multipurpose Pulverizers have already been distributed.

### **Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban)**

Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban) Mission launched on 25th June 2015 which intends to provide housing for all in urban areas by year 2022. The Mission provides Central Assistance to the implementing agencies through States/Union Territories (UTs) and Central Nodal Agencies (CNAs) for providing houses to all eligible families/ beneficiaries against the validated demand for houses for about 1.12 cr. As per PMAY(U) guidelines, the size of a house for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) could be up to 30 sq. mt. carpet area, however States/UTs have the flexibility to enhance the

size of houses in consultation and approval of the Ministry. In continuation to this Government's efforts towards empowerment of women from EWS and LIG unlike earlier schemes, PMAY (U) has made a mandatory provision for the female head of the family to be the owner or co-owner of the house under this Mission.

## **A BRIEF DESCRIPTION ON ACTIVITIES OF BONGAIGAON W.R. DIVISION, BONGAIGAON**

### **REPORT OF BONGAIGAON W.R. DIVISION**

The Bongaigaon district is criss-crossed with numbers of rivers, streams like Aie, Manas, Champabati, Kanibhur, Kujia, Tunia etc. and even mighty river Brahmaputra. The district Bongaigaon has been seen to get affected with flood-inundation and erosion mostly by ferocity of river Aie. The right-bank of river Aie is guarded with WRD-bundh of totaling **28.297Km** (i.e. 3.257Km+25.04Km) against inundation problem.

Bongaigaon W.R. Division has completed 6-nos of schemes in the year 2023. Out of these one scheme is executed on the left bank of river Aie and four numbers of schemes are executed on the right bank of river Aie. Altogether these five schemes cover total 2500m bank revetment and launching apron with Geo-bag and a reach of 4000m is covered by launching of PSC Porcupine screen and earth work in embankment for a length of 4000m including breach closing work. One scheme is executed on the right bank of river Brahmaputra for recoupment of Pachonia area covering a reach of 1500m.

### **MGNREGA**

Bongaigaon Zilla Parishad has been entrusted with key role in the matter of administration, planning implementation and monitoring of MGNREGA in Bongaigaon district. The launching of MGNREGA in this district in the month of February, 2006 has brought a fundamental and visible change in the lives of the rural people of the district. Needless to mention that the implementation of durable & productive schemes under MGNREGA in this district in a transparent manner adhering to the prescribed guidelines contributed remarkably towards the upliftment of economic condition and social status of rural people as well as in sustainable development of the rural area.

In the year 2022-23, total 36,164 nos of schemes were taken up including the houses of PMAY-G, out of which 15,766 nos schemes has been completed and remaining are in progress. Rs 4,979.61lakhs has been received and utilised for implementation of the schems. 5,700 nos of household were provided employment and generated 22.00 lakhs persondays . All total 668 nos of families were provided employment for 100 days.

During the year 2023-24, total 5,659 nos of schemes were taken up, out of which 963 nos schemes has been completed and remaining are in progress. Rs.4,404.43 lakhs has been received and utilised for implementation of the schems. 46,972 nos of household were provided employment and generated 17.60 lakhs persondays. All total 61 nos of families were provided employment for 100 days as on date.

**Amrit Sarovars**

Water is one of the most important natural resources. It is an invaluable gift of nature to the entire human race. Two third of the earth is covered with water. But only 2%-3% of available water is usable. Today, many countries of the world, including India are facing acute water crisis. Realizing the same problem, as per instruction of Govt. 75 Amrit Sarovars have been constructed in this district.

Mission Amrit Sarovar is for construction/development of atleast 75 Amrit Sarovars in every district which not only plays an important role in increasing the availability of water, both on surface and under-ground, but also acts as an income generating asset through pisciculture and commercial plantation.

Total 76 nos. of Amrit Sarovars were sanctioned for construction in Bongaigaon district vide letter No. RDD.62/2022/32 dated 10<sup>th</sup> June, 2022. The construction works of Amrit Sarovars are divided into three parts ie. (i). Excavation which were executed under CMSGUY, (ii). Plantaion, construction of fencing and workshed executed under MGNREGA scheme and (iii). Installation of Solar light on the embankments of Amrit Sarovars under 15<sup>th</sup> FC.

The excavation part of the 76 nos. of Amrit Sarovars have already been completed. (But out of these, one Amrit Sarovar had been washed away by the flood water of rive Aie).

Plantaion and fencing against the 13 nos. of Amrit Sarovars have been completed.

It may be mentioned here that the works under MGNREGA and 15<sup>th</sup> FC are not necessary inrespect of Amrit Sarovars excavated in forest area. Therefore, incase of 6 nos. of such Amrit Sarovars, the other works are not necessary.

### **PMAY-G**

Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) has been providing assistance to BPL families since inception who are either houseless or having inadequate housing facilities for constructing a safe and durable shelter. This effort to the part of a larger strategy of the Ministry's poverty eradication effort and supporting sustainable development of society.

Total 56,092 nos of houses were sanctioned in respect of "Kutcha House" for both old & new PWL under SECC, out of which 50,652 nos of houses were completed as on date and the construction of remaining 5,440nos of houses are in progress.

Total 4642 nos of houses were sanctioned in respect of "Awaas Plus" for the year 2021-22 and 2023-24, out of which 2,512 nos of houses were completed and the construction of remaining 2130 are in progress.

The target is fixed for completed of all PMAY-G houses by November /2023. The wages of 95 days @ of Rs. 238.00 per day is being paid as per guidelines of MGNREGA to the beneficiaries against each PMAY-G house.

## **Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM)**

Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) under Panchayat & Rural Development Department is a poverty alleviation program implemented by the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India. It aims to reduce poverty by enabling the poor household to access gainful self-employment resulting in sustainable and diversified livelihood options for the poor through formation of Self Help Groups. There are 8,726 SHGs in the district till date covering about 97,772 households. Bank credit linkage program is one of the major components of NRLM through which the SHGs get access to financial assistance from Banks. In the last FY, 2022-23, 4,884 SHGs were credit linked directly benefitting 58600 SHG members. These funds are utilized in different livelihood activities by SHG members. Major activities that SHG members are undertaking are Livestock, Agriculture, Fishery, Handloom and other non-farm activities. 32,348 members are engaged in different livestock activities like Piggery, Duckery, Poultry, Goatery, Dairy, etc. where Bank Loan amounts are being utilized.

### **1. Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme (P.M.E.G.P.)**

The Prime Minister Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) is a Government of India backed credit linked subsidy scheme. Under this scheme, beneficiaries can get a subsidy amounting to 25% for Urban area and 35% for Rural area, of the project cost from the Government. Maximum Project cost for manufacturing unit is Rs. 50 Lakh and Maximum Project cost for Service/ Trading unit is Rs. 20 Lakh.

### **2. Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME)**

Under this scheme, artisans like carpenter, boat maker or repairer, armorer, blacksmith, hammer and toolkit maker, locksmith, sculptor, goldsmith, potter, cobbler, basket, mat, broom maker, coir weaver, mason, doll and toy making, barber, garland maker, washerman, tailor, fishing net etc. will benefit.

The Handloom and Textiles is one of the oldest Department functioning in Bongaigaon District since its inception as District and Superintendent, Handloom and Textile, North Salmara, Abhayapuri has been managing various developmental works.

The various development schemes implementing in the district by the Department of Handloom and Textiles, North Salmara, Abhayapuri can be stated as follows:

### **(A) Flagship scheme 'SWANIRBHAR NAARI':**

Under this Flagship Scheme 'SWANIRBHAR NAARI' the Traditional Hand-Woven Items are arranged to procure directly from weavers through a dedicated online portal ([swanirbharnaari.assam.gov.in](http://swanirbharnaari.assam.gov.in)) and no middleman would be allowed under the scheme. A total of 10,473 Nos. weavers applied through this portal and 10,085 Nos. of weavers approved in Bongaigaon



District in 1<sup>st</sup> Phase of registration and in 2<sup>nd</sup> Phase registration of weavers is completed on 31/07/2023. Total weavers applied 2223 and approved 2177 Nos.

According to the Handloom Reservation of Articles for production Act – 1985 the manufacturing of Gamocha, Mekhela-Chadar, Dokhona etc. are reserved for exclusive production by Handloom. But some unscrupulous traders are importing and selling of cheap power loom Gamocha and other traditional items reserved under this Act.

To prevent this importing and selling of power loom made Gamocha and others traditional Handloom items, 5 Nos. of (Revenue Circle wise) enforcement squads were constituted for checking of



textiles business establishment in different areas of the District. Special drive by respective enforcement squads were performed in the District.

**(D) SKILL-UPGRADATION TRAINING UNDER SAMARTH SCHEME :**

In Skill-upgradation training under “**Samarth**” Scheme which was sponsored by Ministry of Textiles, Govt. of India - 2 (Two) Nos. of training programs of Handloom & Jacquard Weaving completed on 21/04/2023. One at Jyoti B.K.S.S. Ltd. Vill.: Kothalguri (20 Nos. Trainees) and another at Boitamari (15 Nos. Trainees). The training period was 45 (Forty Five) days.



## Soil Conservation

**DEPARTMENT PROFILE:** Soil Conservation Department is engaged in most effective and gainful management of three vital interdependent natural resources mainly Soil, Water and Vegetation by implementing various activities of land and water management on crop land on a sustained basis. The Soil Conservation Department is responsible for implementation of various schemes on soil and water conservation with the objective of generating income to rural people. This Soil Conservation Department has also taken up numbers of schemes related to control of shifting cultivation in the hill areas of the state by providing alternative practices like horticulture, cash crop development etc. to wean away jhumiyas from harmful practices of shifting cultivation.

### OBJECTIVES:

- i. To reduce all forms of soil erosion.
- ii. To increase agricultural productivity in sustained manner without deteriorating the soil health.
- iii. Efficient use of rainfall and development of water conservation and harvesting structures such as farm ponds, check dams, nallah bunds, percolation tanks etc.
- iv. Restoration of ecological balance by harnessing, conserving and developing natural resources.
- v. To minimize flood hazards in the valley bottom areas and farm lands by way of preventing silt deposition in the riverbed.
- vi. Protection of paddy land from throwing of sand during flood season to some extent.

## **Fishery**

### **VARIOUS ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED BY DEPARTMENT OF FISHERIES, BONGAIGAON UNDER PMMSY, APART AND RIDF SCHEMES DURING THE YEAR 2022-23 AND ACHIEVEMENTS THERE ON.**

Department of Fisheries, Bongaigaon have been implementing various components under different departmental schemes such as PMMSY (Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana), APART (Assam Agribusiness and Rural Transformation Project) and RIDF (Rural Infrastructure Development Fund) for the development of Inland Fisheries and Aquaculture. It includes technology infusion and adaptation, Infrastructure and post harvest management, livelihood and nutritional support for fishers etc.

Under the scheme PMMSY, 2022-23; different activities has been implemented such as, Construction of New Pond (38 nos, W/A- 11ha), Construction of Rearing Pond (46 nos, W/A- 8 ha), Inputs for Fish Farming (38 nos, W/A- 11ha), Inputs for Integrated Fish farming (21 nos, W/A- 6.5 ha), Fingerling Stocking in Wetlands (5 nos. W/A- 90 ha), Pen Culture (2 nos, W/A- 2 ha), Boats and Nets (2 nos), Backyard Ornamental Fish Rearing Unit (4 nos), Mini Feed Mill (1no, capacity 2 ton/day), Large Feed Mill (1 no, capacity 20 ton/day), Finfish Hatchery (2 nos) and Livelihood support to Fishers (500 nos).

Under the scheme APART, 2022-23; Polyculture Demonstration of 14 nos of ponds with total water area 5 ha has been implemented.

Under the scheme RIDF XXVI, 9 nos of 3 wheeler vehicles (fish carrying vehicle with ice box) have been distributed among the selected beneficiaries of the district.

Besides, the Department has also sponsored 771 nos KCC (Kisan Credit Card) applications in different banks of the district and out of these 63 nos of application got sanctioned. Moreover, under GAIS (Group Accident Insurance Scheme) about 2800 nos of fishers has been covered during 2022-23.

#### **GLIMPSE OF ACHIEVEMENTS OF DEPARTMENT OF FISHERIES, BONGAIGAON.**

##### **1. NAZMIN YASMIN. (Block- Boitamari) (INTEGRATED ORNAMENTAL UNIT)**

He is a successful ornamental fish farmer of Bongaigaon district. He has been selected by the Department of Fisheries, Assam for the construction of one Integrated Ornamental Unit under fisheries sector under the PMMSY scheme implemented for the year 2022-23. The project cost is 25 lakh of which 60% is the Govt share. This unit has been introduced for certain purpose such as, breeding of various high valued ornamental fishes e.g. gold fish, guppies and molly, Koi carp, Sucker fish, Angel fish, Sword Tailed and also certain indigenous fishes of Assam such as zebra fish (dorikona) kholihona, botia. His net annual income from the unit is approx. 2-3 lakh.

##### **2. Mr. JOYDEV SARKAR. (Block- Manikpur) (MINI FISH FEED MILL)**

One of the progressive fish farmers of Bongaigaon district, selected for the Construction of Mini Fish feed mill under the PMMSY scheme, 2020-21 implemented for the year 2021-22. Total project cost was 30 lakh, of which he received 40% as Govt subsidy. He successfully ended up with the construction of the feed mill with the annual production of approx 576 ton and with a net annual income of 6-7 lakh. This added to the availability of quality fish feed in the locality and also for marketing outside. Along with



this he is involved with other fisheries activities such as production of fish, breeding of high valued fishes such as magur, singhi, gulcha etc, and also related with biofloc.

### **3. Mrs. Kalpana Choudhury.( Block- Tapattary) (RECREATIONAL FISHERY )**

She has selected for the Construction of Recreational Fishery under the PMMSY Scheme, 2021-22 implemented for the year 2022-23. The fishery unit consists of 4 numbers of Angling Deck, 1 no of Aquarium house, 2 nos Boat and a Restaurant having fish products as food items along with 1 set of cottage or rest room. The project cost was 50 lakh of which 60% was Govt Subsidy. The project was successfully constructed and now it attracts a good numbers of tourists which increased the net annual income of the resort upto approx 6-7 lakh. It also increased the aesthetic beauty of the site.



### **4. Mr. ABU BAKKAR SIDDIQUE. (Block- Manikpur) (THE BEST FISH SEED PRODUCER OF ASSAM AWARDEE)**

Mr. Abu Bakkar Siddique is one of the most successful and well known fish farmers of Bongaigaon honoured with 'THE BEST FISH SEED PRODUCER OF ASSAM' award for the year 2022. He made start up as a fish seed trader. Initially he started fish breeding using the Hapa Technique. Later he started Eco-Hatchery which added to his both asset and fish seed production. Presently, he owns a farm with water area approx. 12 Ha (6 nos of nursery ponds, 6 nos rearing ponds and 8 nos of stocking ponds). Total annually production from his hatchery is 3.9 crore spawn, 1 crore fry, 5 lakhs fingerlings. Annual Production of table fish from his farms till date is 30 MT. His annual turnover is approx. 30 lakhs from fisheries sector.



5. Construction work of a Large Feed Mill (capacity 20 ton/ day) under PMMSY Scheme, 2022-23 is going on at Goraimari, Manikpur Dev. Block. The expected date of completion of the project is 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2023. The project cost is 2 crore and Govt. subsidy of 60%. On completion it will not only fulfill the demand for quality fish feed in the district but also outside the district in near future.

## National Informatics Centre Bongaigaon District Centre

### Achievements for the year 2022-2023

National Informatics Centre under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) is the technology partner of the Government of India and the primary objective of NIC is to setup, implement and support all the IT-led programs of both central and state governments, including other government organization. The NIC, Bongaigaon District Centre has been providing all kind of supports, consultancy in setting up of IT infrastructure and in implementation of IT-led programs since inception.

A glimpse of achievements for the year 2022-2023 may be summarised as follows::

**SPs Conference under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Chief Minister Assam::** All kind of technical supports provided for setting up of VC, Network and IT support in 9 various locations including the main locations at Convention Centre and Bongaigaon College Field on 27-07-2023 and 28-07-2023.



**eOffice implementation in DC's Office:** The eOffice, a product of NIC aims to support governance by ushering in more effective and transparent inter and intra-government processes. The vision of e-Office is to achieve a simplified, responsive, effective and transparent working of all government offices.

As per decision of Government, all kind necessary supports provided in implementation of eOffice in the office of the District Commissioner, Bongaigaon. Many activities like creation of e-Mail in Govt Domain, setting up of Network, capacity building etc were carried out for smooth implementation of eOffice. Total **2450** no of old files digitized and uploaded in eOffice application and all the officials/staff are working in eOffice Application for seamless movement of files.



**Conduct of Video Conferencing ::** With upgraded state-of-art technology in all locations, NIC provides one of the largest High Definition Video Conferencing Network in the country. Conducting indoor/outdoor video conferencing for District Administration along with others department in the district without any hassle. During the year 2022-2023, total 434 no of State/National Level VC conducted in NIC VC platform.



### **Integrated Road Accident Database (iRAD)::**

The Integrated Road Accident Database (iRAD) Project is an initiative of the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH), Government of India and is funded by World Bank, with objective to improve road safety in the country. To achieve this, establishment of an accurate and uniform road accident data collection mechanism from all over India, is required. For this purpose iRAD mobile & web application is developed. This is followed by training & handholding support to stakeholder departmental users through state / district roll out managers & master trainers.

**This will facilitate road accident data collection by mainly 4 stakeholder departments Police, Transport, Highways, Health Departments**

**Many rounds of training programs have been conducted by NIC,Bongaigaon for the stakeholder departments and support has also been provided to the stakeholder to ensure smooth implementation and functioning of iRAD.**



## Samagra Shiksha, Bongaigaon has taken holistic approach in the field of education in Bongaigaon district.

Following activities were conducted at district, block and school level.

### 1. Janabhagidari

**Objective:** To create the awareness about NEP 2020, G20 and NIPUN AXOM Mission ,**One day district level workshop** was organized on ‘Janbhagidari’ The topics covered at district level Janbhagidari programme were, NIPUN AXOM and G20.

**TLM exhibition** was organized on the same day in which the teachers displayed the low cost TLMs prepared by them for effective classroom transaction.

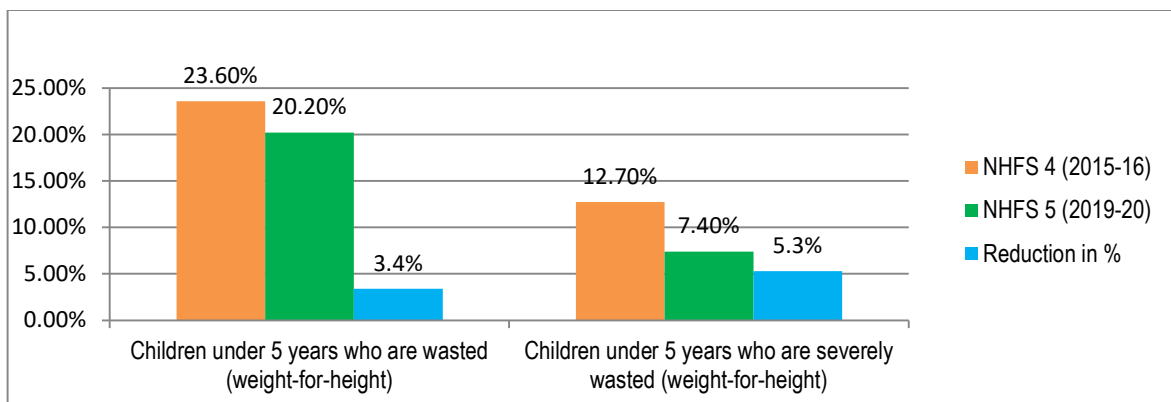
• **Poshan Abhiyaan**

POSHAN Abhiyaan was launched in March 2018 to achieve improvement in nutritional status of Children from 0-6 years, Adolescent Girls, Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers in a time bound manner and to achieve reduction in stunting and wasting in children (0-6 years) as well as reduction in anemia in women, children and adolescent girls.

Malnutrition is an imbalance in dietary intake. Wasting is defined as low weight-for-height and Stunting is defined as low height-for-age. Wasting and Stunting in children are both associated with a higher risk of death. Wasting is the most immediate, visible and life-threatening form of malnutrition.



**The rate of wasted children and Severely Wasted children in the Bongaigaon District has decreased to 3.4 % & 5.3% respectively as per NHFS (National Health & Family Survey) report on weight-for-height of children . Children with wasting are too thin and their immune systems are weak, leaving them vulnerable to developmental delays, disease and death.**



An intervention has been implemented named **Project Sampoorna** by District Administration Bongaigaon in collaboration with Social Welfare Department and other line department in Bongaigaon district to reduce child malnutrition. This project has resulted in reduction of malnutrition in children by 95.6 % within 1 year in Bongaigaon district using very less economic investment presenting **BUDDY Mother Concept**. **The project and Bongaigaon district has been awarded with the Prime Minister's Award for Excellence in Public Administration, 2021 in Innovation Category by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India.**

A major plank of Poshan Abhiyan is Behaviour Change Communication through Jan Andolan activities includes Annaprasan Diwas, Suposhan Diwas, Celebrating coming of age – getting ready for preschool at AWC, Messages related to public health for improvement of nutrition and to reduce illness annaprasan diwas, Suposhan Diwas, etc.

Rastriya Poshan Maah is celebrated every year in September and Poshan Pakhwada is celebrated for 15 days in March to strengthen public participation and ensure health and nutrition for all to address malnutrition in women and children.

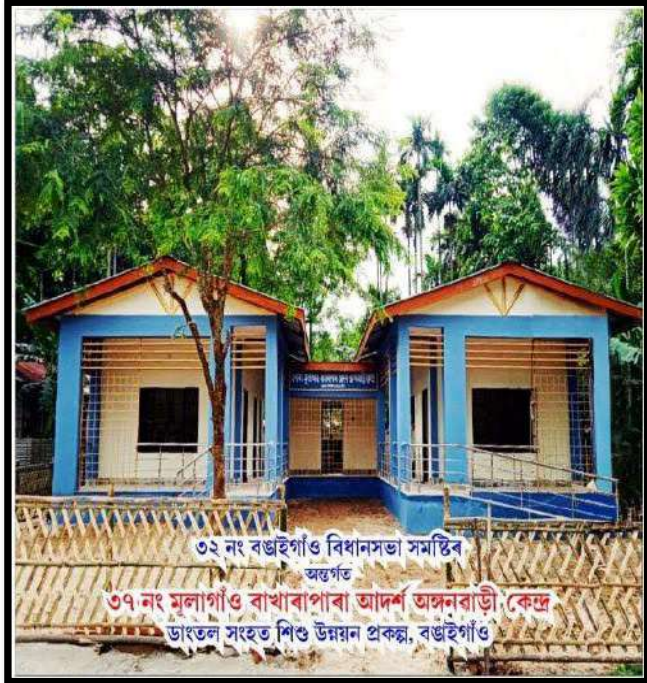


• **Model Anganwadi Centre**

• **PRADHAN MANTRI MATRU VANADANA YOJANA (PMMVY)**

The main objective of the scheme is to provides cash incentives for pregnant and lactating mothers for partial compensation of wage loss and to improve health seeking behaviour amongst the Pregnant Women & Lactating Mothers (PW&LM).

## **DISTRICT TRANSPORT OFFICE, BONGAIGAON** **Transport Department.**

The function of the Transport Department are mainly, 1) Public awareness on Road safety, 2) Implementation of MV Act and Rules, 3) Revenue collection.

Road safety and public awareness is a major function of the Transport Department. To mitigate accident several steps have been initiated by the Transport Department viz.

- 1) Regular Eye checkup camp of the driver and conductor of buses and other vehicle.
- 2) Road side public awareness meeting at different black spot of Bongaigaon District, at Kisan Bazer, Chaprakata, Rakhaldubi, Manikpur, Gerukabari, Kakoijana, Tulungia, Talguri and Jogighopa, near Pancharatna Bridge.
- 3) Road safety week was conducted from January, 11<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2023 in Bongaigaon District to create awareness among mass people regarding Road safety.
- 4) Regular day & night Enforcement drive in the whole district against the M.V. Act & Rules violation along with road side awareness meeting among the mass people of Bongaigaon District, to mitigate accident.
- 5) Street drama at different place of Bongaigaon for road safety awareness.
- 6) At present Transport Department has launched four schemes to give relieve to the tax defaulter, a) Tax rebate up 75% on scrapped vehicle, b) Concession on fitness fine, c) One Time Settlement Scheme for the owner tax defaulting vehicle to clear the M.V. tax with specified waiving of tax and d) Digitization of Driving Licence and Registration Certificate.
- 7) The revenue target for the financial year 2023-24 in Rs. 36,50,00,000.00 for Bongaigaon District till September, 2023. Rs. 18,65,51,666.00 has been collected till September, 2023. And we have achieved 51.11% of the revenue target fixed by the Transport Department.
