The meeting was chaired by Sri Dibakar Nath, District Commissioner, Bongaigaon. He welcomed all the officials present in the meeting and reviewed the status of all parameters fixed by the State and Central Govt. He requested all concerned departmental heads to dedicate themselves for the welfare of the people and to keep an eye on their departmental parameters to achieve the target within the stipulated time. He requested them to compare their District achievement with that of other districts and State as a whole and to take steps for its enhancement.

The House then reviewed the progress of schemes implemented by different departments.
