The meeting was presided over by Shri Nabadeep Pathak, ACS, Deputy Commissioner, Bongaigaon. At the outset, the Chairman welcomed all the members present in the meeting. Initiating the meeting the Deputy Commissioner, Bongaigaon informed that the next DC's Conference has been fixed from 12/05/2023 to 14/05/2023 at Tinisukia. Accordingly, the Govt. has directed to submit a compiled report on Monitorable target (total=53 points) and Monitorable indicators for the aforesaid Conference. The Chairman then reviewed the point wise agenda mentioned on the Monitorable target and Monitorable indicators with the line departments through power point presentation. He requested all the concerned departments to submit relevant reports on Monitorable target and Monitorable indicators with reasons for short fall by today itself for compilation.

The house then reviewed the programmes of different departments and follow up actions of the last DDC meeting.
