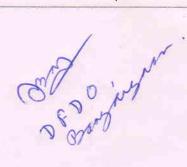

Part.V. Recommendation of the M&E Observer:

Self alongwith DFDO, Bonagigaon and FDO, Bongaigaon and Research Assistant, D.C's office, Bongaigaon visited the site on 28/12/2022. It has been observed that a Recreational Fishery under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY), 2021-22 has been sanctioned to Smti. Kalpana Choudhury, Dharampur Ward No.1, Abhayapuri. The scheme was sanctioned to attract tourist, employment generation for local people, and to increase interest in people on water sports activities like angling, boating. Besides, there is aquarium, cottage room, Restaurant with Kitchen, toilets facilities in the campus, which is clubbed with Aastha Resort at Abhayapuri. It is assume that with time the scheme will earn more income earning and will encourage tourism. So far, the construction of 3 out of 4 nos. angling deck are ready. Aquarium House, 3 nos. Cottage Room, Restaurant with Kitchen, Gents and Ladies toilets are completed. Overall the quality of the work is good.

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
